Dear Parent and Carers,

It has been a very quick few weeks and I can't quite believe that we are starting to plan for the end of term and Christmas!! I have included a list of important dates at the end of the newsletter

Homework

Each class teacher provides homework tasks on SEESAW. These tasks will consolidate and reinforce the learning in class, however these activities are entirely optional. We understand the pressures that families are under after school with clubs and other family commitments. We hope that our approach provides you with the tools to support your child with their learning, if you so wish, without being pressured with time constraints.

Parking and Vehicle Access

Thank you for your support in adhering to restricted vehicle access to our school. By closing the gates at specific times, it now means that our children can enter, exit and play safely throughout our school grounds. I appreciate that parking around the school is difficult and I would respectfully ask everyone to park responsibly.

Dogs

Unfortunately, we are experiencing a significant amount of dog mess in our playground and on too many occasions our children clothes and shoes are covered, which is a health and safety risk. I have been discussing the issue with Facilities Management and they are looking into ways to reduce this. One possible idea would be to lock our gates at the weekend. I know this is not ideal as many of our children like to play in the grounds but the dog mess is causing a real concern.

Wider Achievement

As a school, we regularly celebrate our learners' achievements. Many of our them have had fantastic successes outside of school in sporting, charity work and other clubs. We have a wall outside the hall to display these and we would ask parents to email the school office with the information and photographs if appropriate.

Book Fair

Thank you to those who purchased for the Scholastic Book Fair last month. We have been able to raise \pounds 1254 in commission to spend on other scholastic material. This will support our current development in reading and our journey as a reading school.

Attendance

Balmuildy Primary School recognises that education brings a wide range of benefits to children. Good attendance is key to educational success, helping children build and maintain good relationships with their peers and staff, and to develop to their full potential.

The attendance research table below shows what attendance percentages equate to in terms of missed school days over a school year.

Attendance %	Days missed over a school year	What research tells us
95%	9 days (nearly 2 weeks)	Attendance at or above this level gives a learner the best chance of success.
90%	19 days (nearly 4 weeks)	Attendance at this level leads to less chance of success. Data shows that learners missing this much school could drop a whole grade in secondary.
80-85%	27-36 days (5-7 weeks)	Attendance at this level has serious implications for learning and progress.

In order to provide appropriate support, attendance will be regularly reviewed and where attendance is below 90%, we will link with families. I have also attached an Attendance Matters Poster, which will be posted on our school website.

PTA Events

It's that time of year when we are looking towards the PTA Christmas Fayre. This year it is held on **Saturday 30th November**. For the Christmas Fayre each class is asked to make up a hamper to put into the raffle. We allocate a colour to each class and ask pupils to bring in something of that colour.
