School Improvement Priorites

As part of our continuous improvement journey, we create an improvement plan that outlines our priorties and how we will achieve and measure these over the session. This session we have 3 main priorties

Library visits

As part of our Reading Schools Journey, all classes will have a visit to the local library. These will start on the 12^{th} of September and all classes, weather permitting, will have a visit before December. As part of these visit the children can apply for a library card or bring their own.

Flu immunisation

The NHS flu Immunisation Team will be in our school on 25th of September, if you wish your child to receive this please ensure the permission slips are returned to the school as soon as possible. The team only bring enough to immunise the number of permission slips they have had returned. Unfortunately, if your child is absent on 25th of September, then parents should make alternative arrangements through the NHS.

Dogs

May I respectfully remind all Parents and Carers that there should be no dogs in our playground at drop off and pick up times. Some of our children are not familiar with dogs and can become upset if they are near them. We would appreciate your support in this matter.

Water Bottles

Just a reminder that all children should have a water bottle and these can be refilled during breaks and lunchtime. Unfortunately, we only have a limited supply of cups.

Individual and sibling's photographs will be taken on 8th of October for those who wish photographs to be taken. Unfortunately, sibling photographs can only include those children in our school.

The annual book fair will be in the school from 7^{th} to 10^{th} of October. As in previous year children will have an opportunity to visit the fair and will bring home a slip of any book they would like to purchase.

Physical Education



In order to maximise the safety of pupils no jewellery is permitted to be worn during PE lessons. Pierced earrings must be removed; children who cannot remove their earrings will unfortunately be unable to participate in PE lessons. Can you please ensure pupils come to school fully prepared with their PE kit each week.

Allergy Information

Due to several pupils with allergies we are a nut free school. It is important that pupils do not bring nuts or nut products to school as a snack or in their packed lunches. This includes any products which may contain nuts such as hazelnut chocolate spread.

We encourage pupils not to share or swap snacks in case they contain any

hidden traces of nuts. We also ask that children do not bring birthday cake to school to share with their class due to a number of allergies across the school.
