Alan Glen Donation

I am delighted to announce we have received a quantity of sports equipment from the charity, Allan Glen's 2012 Trust.

Allan Glen's, probably best known today for the Rugby Club in Bishopbriggs, was a secondary school in Glasgow which closed in the 1980's. The Trustees of the 2012 Trust are mainly former pupils of that school and are keen to support primary educational and sporting activities in the area surrounding their old school's playing fields.

The equipment, which includes athletics, hockey, touch rugby and volleyball kit will be used to support the teaching of specific sports during P. E sessions and then used by children at breaks and lunchtime. The equipment will help develop sporting skills and encourage leadership and teamwork while making a positive impact on health, fitness and wellbeing. It is all part of the education of our young people and we are grateful to Allan Glen's for this kind contribution.



Creating Engineering Competition

Our Primary 5 and Primary 6 pupils are taking part in the Creating Engineering Competition 2025 which involves demonstrating their building skills using the construction materials, K'Nex. Pupils will work in pairs and will be judged using strict criteria.
