1st Prize Leo P2b 2nd Prize Liam P1b 3rd Prize Abigail P2a Well done!





Mrs Thomson also had lots of help from P4 pupils to help her grow the remainder of the bulbs. A fantastic display of Pink & White Hyacinths.
